Call for Abstracts

Call for Abstracts for AONS 2019 is Now Open...

Abstracts related to studies on evidence-based practice in Oncology Nursing are invited for oral and poster presentation. All candidates selected for oral and paper presentation must complete the registration process.

The following information is provided to guide you through the abstract submission process:

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- All abstracts must be submitted online through our website
- Word limit- 500 words (3780 characters including spaces) or less for abstracts that are text only. One figure or 1 table can be included
- Abstracts over the word limit will be rejected
- The presenter has to underline their name in case of more than one author.
- All abstracts can be submitted no later than 11:59 pm on 30th June 2019
- Abstracts will be selected for Oral & Poster presentation and the confirmation for the same will be intimated by email by 15th July 2019
- Best oral and poster presentations will be awarded (Three for each category)
- One author can submit only 1 abstract for judging
- Your abstract should adhere to the following format:

 - Purpose/Objective
 - Background
 - Method
 - Result
 - Conclusion
 - Implications of Nursing
